


STEP BY STEP

TO ATTACH TWO AXIS RECEPTACLES







Insert top attachment plate

- Each Axis Receptacle needs one attachment plate and four bolts. To attach two receptacles you will need two attachment plates and eight screws.
- Insert top attachment plate (b) into slot along the straight flat end of the receptacle, below the lid.
- Align holes in top attachment plate with holes in top receptacle frame.

Attach top attachment plate

- Insert 1/4"-20 x 1/2" bolts (a) through receptacle frame and top attachment plate to secure top attachment plate to receptacle.
- Tighten until snug.

Insert bottom attachment plate

- Insert bottom attachment plate (b) into slot along the straight flat end of the receptacle, below the body and above the base.
- Align holes in bottom attachment plate with holes in bottom receptacle frame.





TO ATTACH TWO AXIS RECEPTACLES




Attach bottom attachment plate

- Insert 1/4"-20 x 1/2" head bolts (a) through receptacle frame and bottom attachment plate to secure bottom attachment plate to receptacle.
- Tighten until snug.



Both attachment plates secured

 Both attachment plates should now be secured on the first receptacle and ready to be attached to the second receptacle.



Align and attach second receptacle

- Align top and bottom attachment plates from the first receptacle with the slots in the second receptacle.
- Secure attachments plates with 1/4"-20 x 1/2" bolts (a) to second receptacle as in Step 2 and Step 4.
- Tighten until snug.
